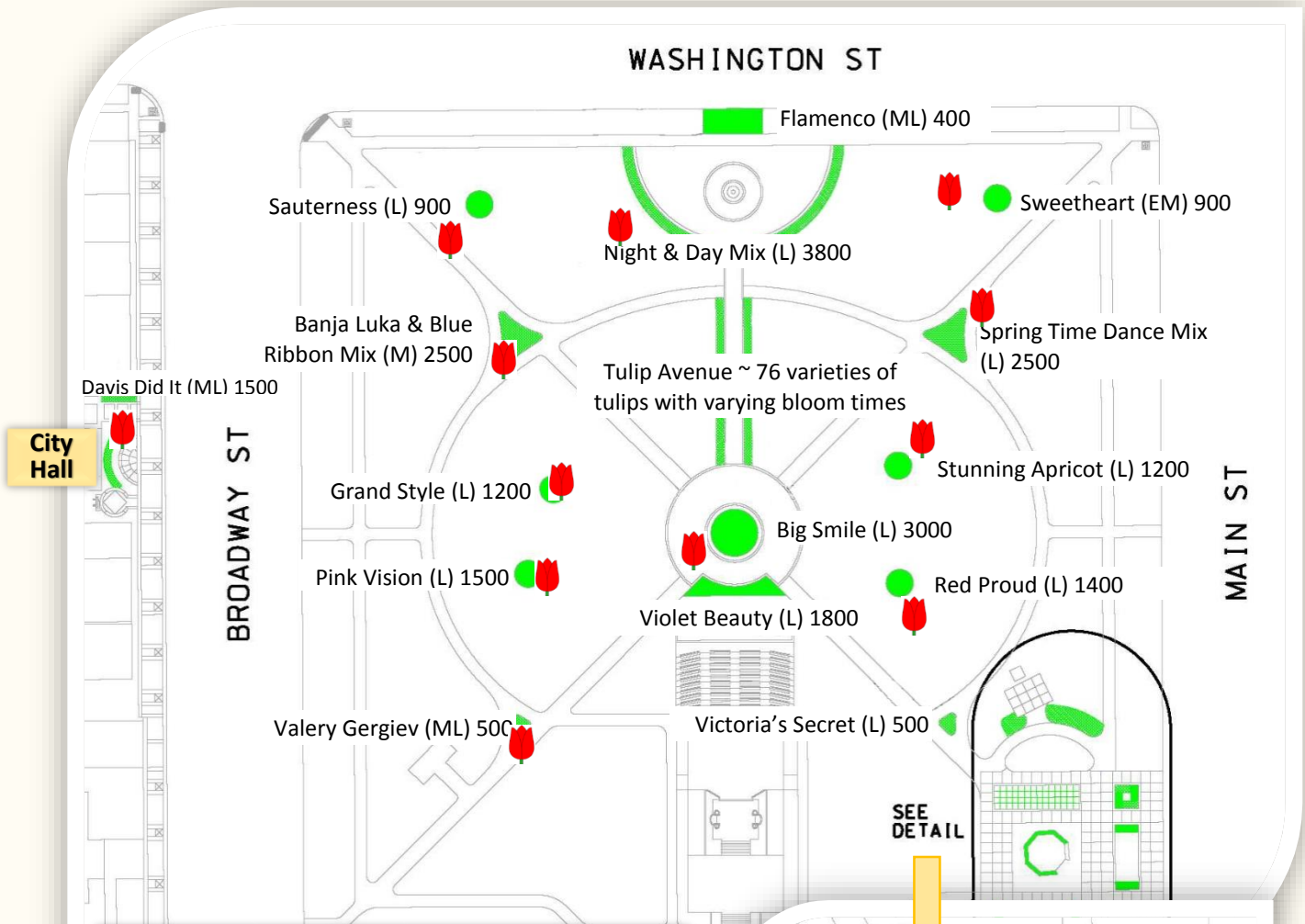


**City of Pella 2016 Tulip Information - All beds are in bloom or showing color.
Bloom Status Updated: 4/26/2016**



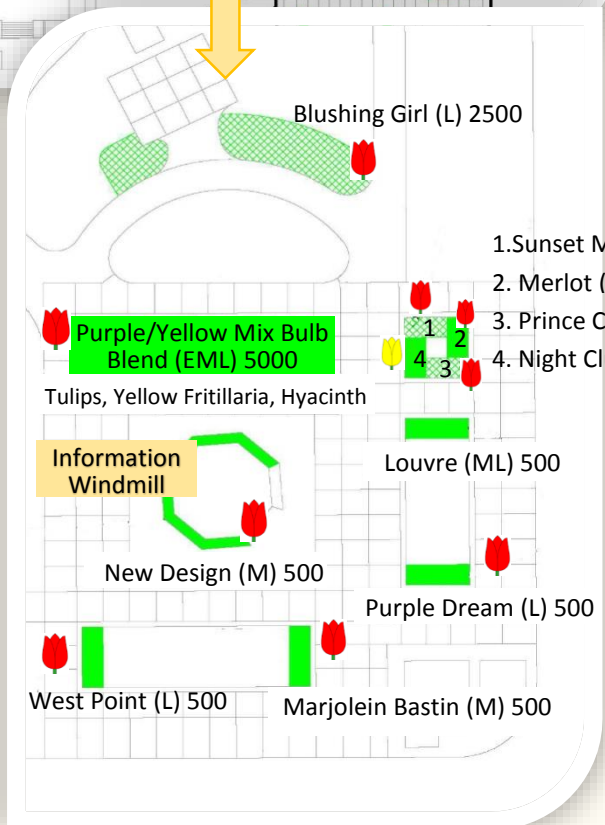
Central Park

The crabapple trees planted to the south of the information windmill are Camelot, those to the east are Guinevere. The rose bushes are Grandma's Blessings.

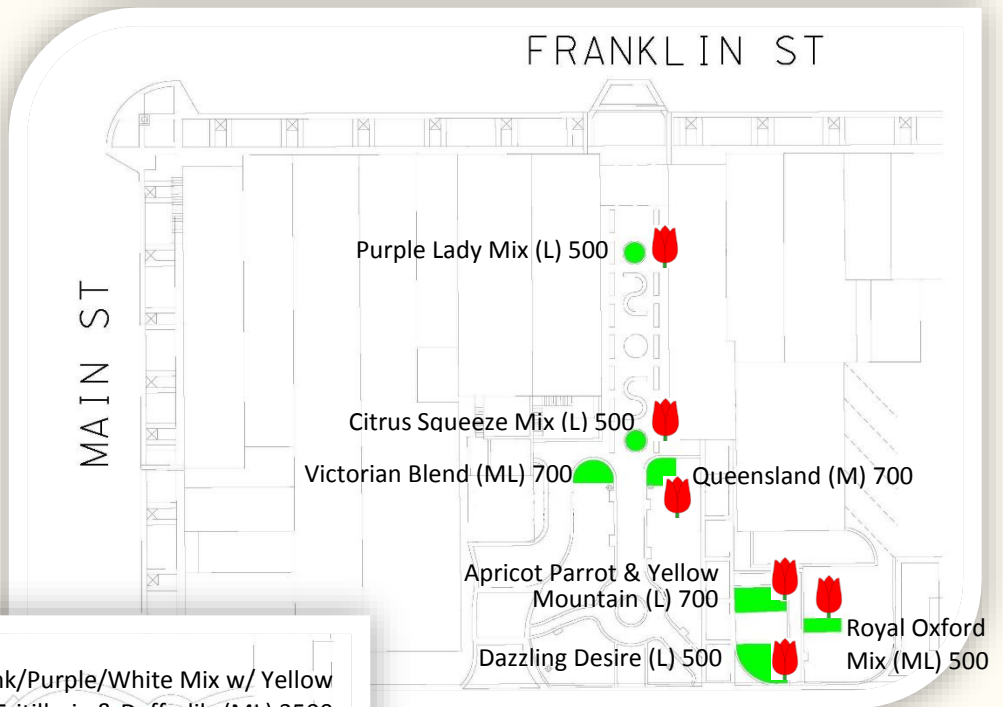

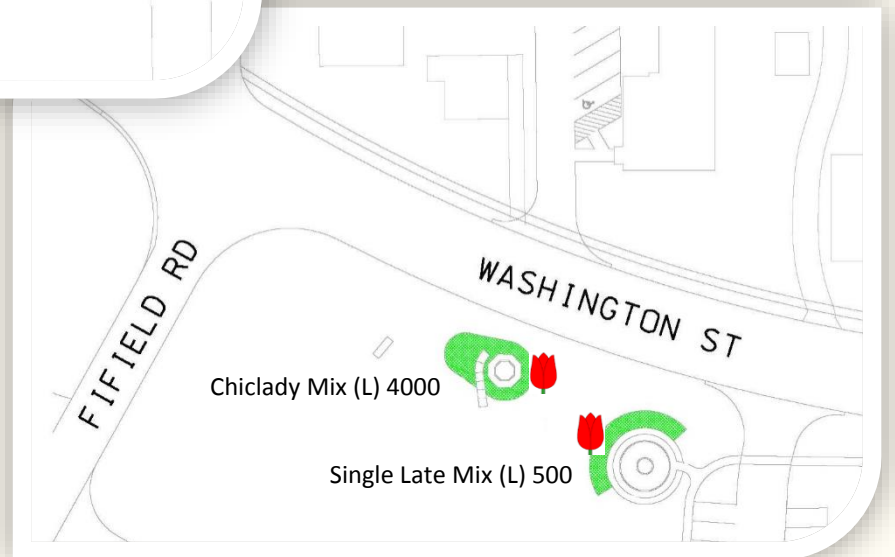

Tulip Facts:

- The City of Pella Parks Department planted over 101,000 tulips in parks and street flower beds. (Over 180 flower beds!)
- 76 different varieties were planted in the Tulip Avenue in Central Park.
- When deciding what bulbs to plant each fall staff considers the following: color, height, location (how much sun/shade), bloom time, surrounding foliage or hardscape and uniqueness.
- Proximity of beds to brick/concrete/buildings that radiate warmth can cause tulips to bloom sooner than expected due to increased soil warmth.
