Tulip Time: We will be open for early morning laps, sr. exercise and lap swim 12-2 p.m. on Thursday and Friday. We will close at 2:00 p.m. We will not be open on Saturday. These are the only times available for those days.

Aquatic Center is scheduled to open on Memorial Day, May 26.

The Pella Aquatic Center with the Adventure River is scheduled to open on Memorial Day, May 26, 2008 at 1:00 pm. Some of the exciting family fun on the Adventure River will be a 494’ river to float around in tubes. Additional amenities include two tube slides, a shallow play area with a family slide, wave generator, water falls, geysers, 300 gallon tidal tank, water arches and much more. When Pella Community School starts in the fall, we will be closed weekdays and open only on the weekends. Labor Day, September 1 will be our last day. (The City reserves the right to close features as needed due to staffing and inclement weather.)

Summer passes can be purchased at any time and dated for Memorial Day. Remember that each member of your family will need photo ID’s. Please don’t wait until Memorial Day to purchase passes!

- The Pella City Council has approved a resident/non resident fee for those people who reside inside or outside the city limits respectively.
- **This daily admission price is good fall, winter and spring. Summer daily admission is \$4.50/ \$5.50 for adult res/non and \$4.00/\$5.00 for youth and sr. res/non.**
- All passes should have photo ID’s. Please bring passes, so they may be scanned for entrance. All year passes are good at the Aquatic Center in the summer! All passes are non-transferable. Family passes are for immediate family members only. Nannies or babysitters need their own pass. Passes for the summer can be purchased at any time for use at the outdoor Aquatic Center. Please purchase passes before Memorial Day to help admission line move faster. We do not refund passes.

Registration: for spring classes will be anytime starting Wednesday, April 9, after the publication of this schedule. Registration will be **at the Indoor Pool**. No registrations are taken over the phone, no IOU registrations. No make-up classes will be given unless, for some reason, we cannot hold a class at its regular time. No refunds are given for classes or passes. If you cannot continue with a session, credit can be given **for medical reasons only, but you must notify the Aquatic Manager before the third lesson in order to receive credit**. We do not give credit after the third lesson. **If you decide to drop out of lessons, there is no refund or credit.**

PRIVATE RENTAL

Make arrangements with the Aquatic Manager **at least two weeks in advance**. All groups coming in during public swim will pay regular admission prices. We are taking reservations for rentals for the outdoor Aquatic Center. If the weather or temperature does not cooperate, rentals may be held at the Indoor Pool. One reservation will hold either facility or you can request the Indoor Pool only. All rentals must be paid in advance unless cleared by the Aquatic Manager. No refunds will be allowed if the Aquatic Manager is not notified three days in advance.

STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH & CENTER FOR DISEASE CONTROL (CDC)

The State of Iowa Department of Health and the CDC have specific protocol for us to follow in the case of a fecal accident in the pool. Handouts are available and should be read prior to attending the Pella Aquatic Facilities. Fecal matter in the pool could require us to get all patrons out of the pool for up to 24 hours or more. The CDC recommends that anyone who has had diarrhea, not swim in public pools for two weeks after. Please refer to Fecal Contamination handouts available at the admission booth.

SWIMMING LESSONS:

PARENT & CHILD SWIM LESSONS

- For children 6 months through 35 months, accompanied by an adult or guardian.
- Any child who is not potty trained must wear a swim diaper.
- Class meets on Monday and Wednesday mornings, 10:30 -11:10 am.
- Meets April 14-May 7.
- Cost: Residents - \$24 with pass, \$44 without pass;
Non-Residents - \$30 with pass, \$54 without pass.

PRESCHOOL, PRE-K, & KINDERGARTEN-AGE SWIM LESSONS

- Designed for children 3-6 years old.
- Anyone who has already attended first grade should be in Red Cross lessons.
- No seven-year old children may sign up for this group.
- Guppies I is the first level of preschool. All beginners would start there.
- Limit 8 per class.
- Classes meet either Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday.
- Session starts April 14 or 15 and ends May 7 or 13. No class Thursday May 1.
- Cost: Residents - \$24 with pass, \$44 without pass;
Non-Residents - \$30 with pass, \$54 without pass.

- Meets are on Tuesday evenings starting June 17 (tentative date).
- Every swimmer must have a pass to the pool.
- Cost is Residents \$26.00, Non-Residents \$31.00.
