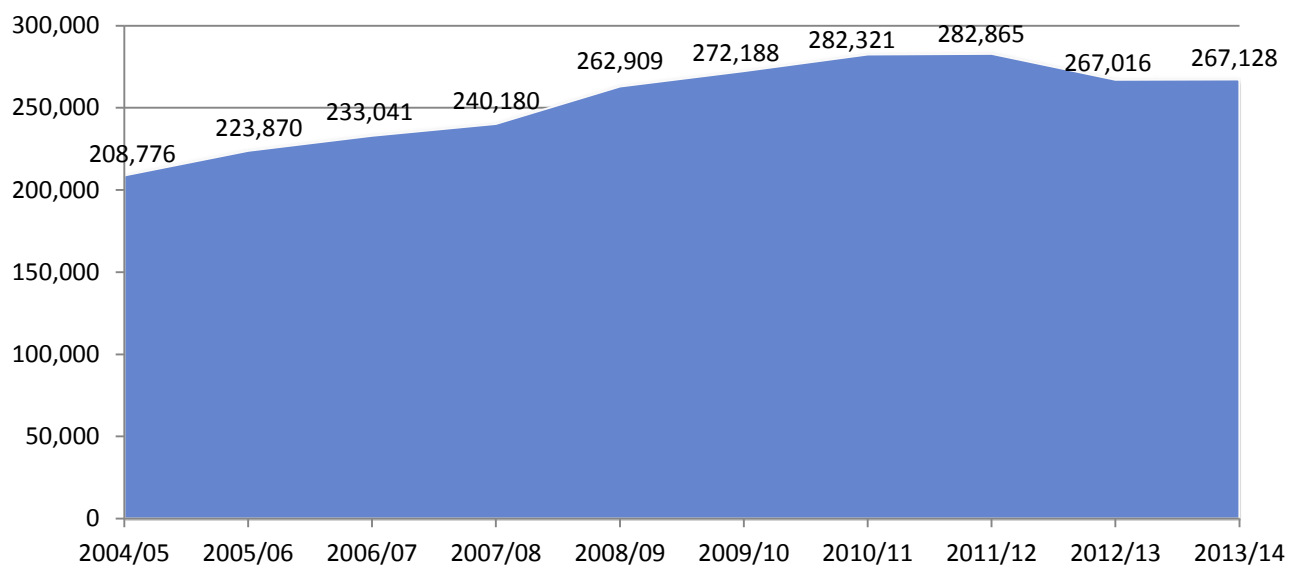

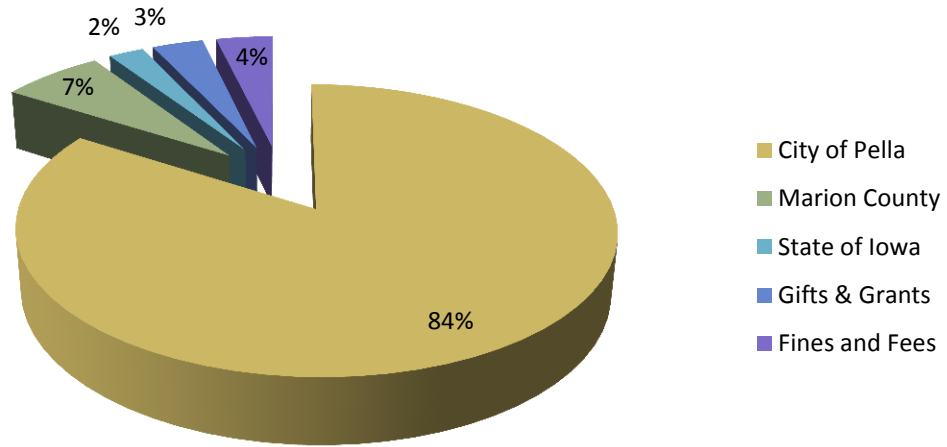

Ten Year Circulation History

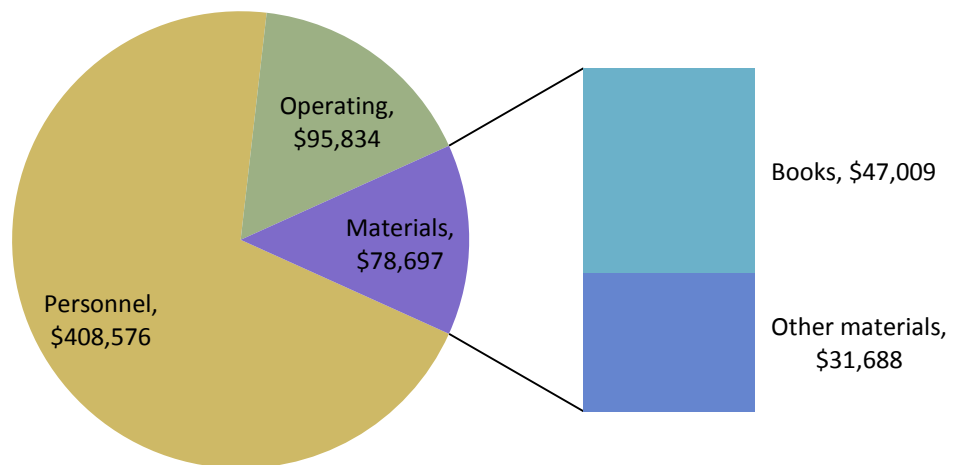

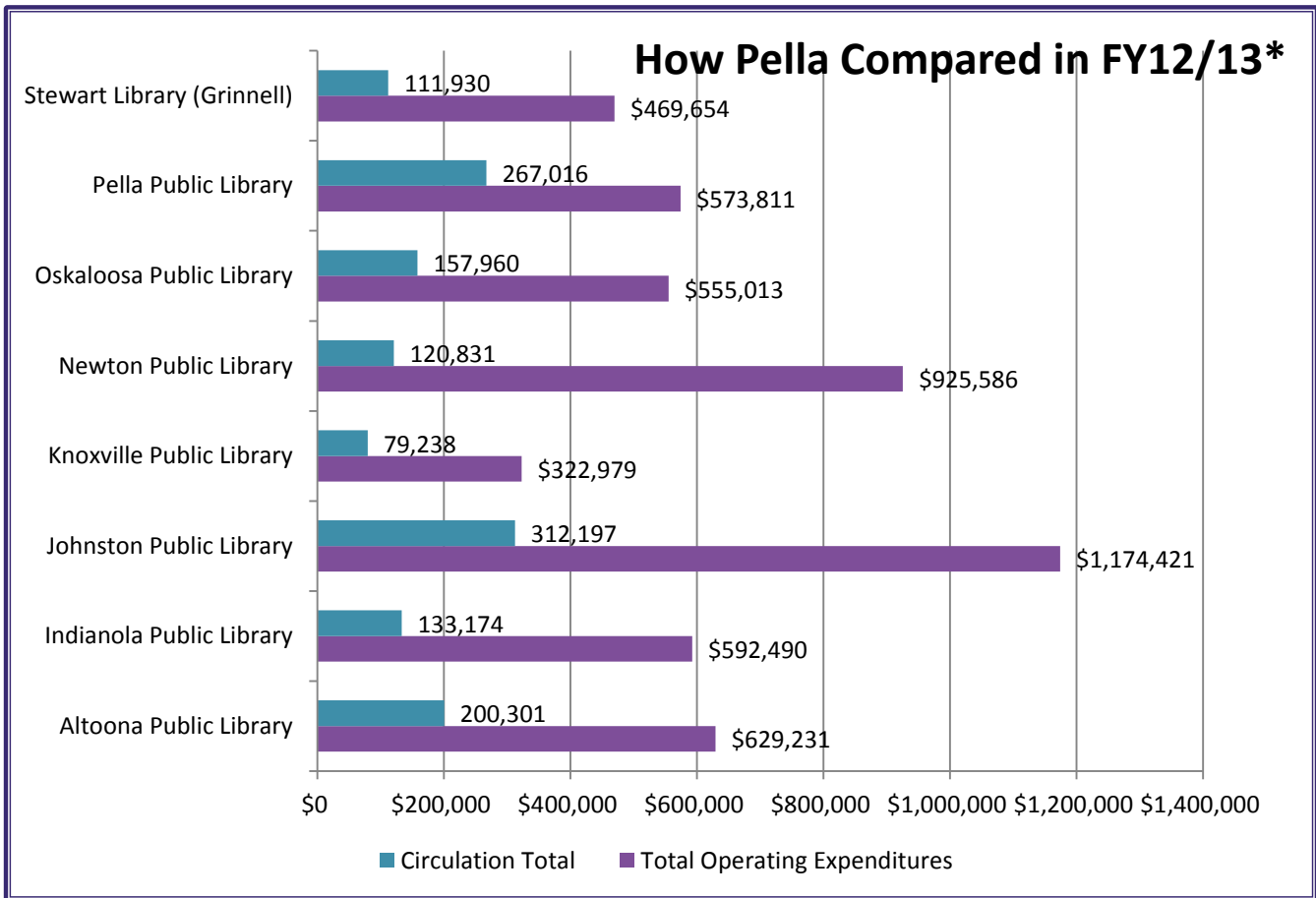
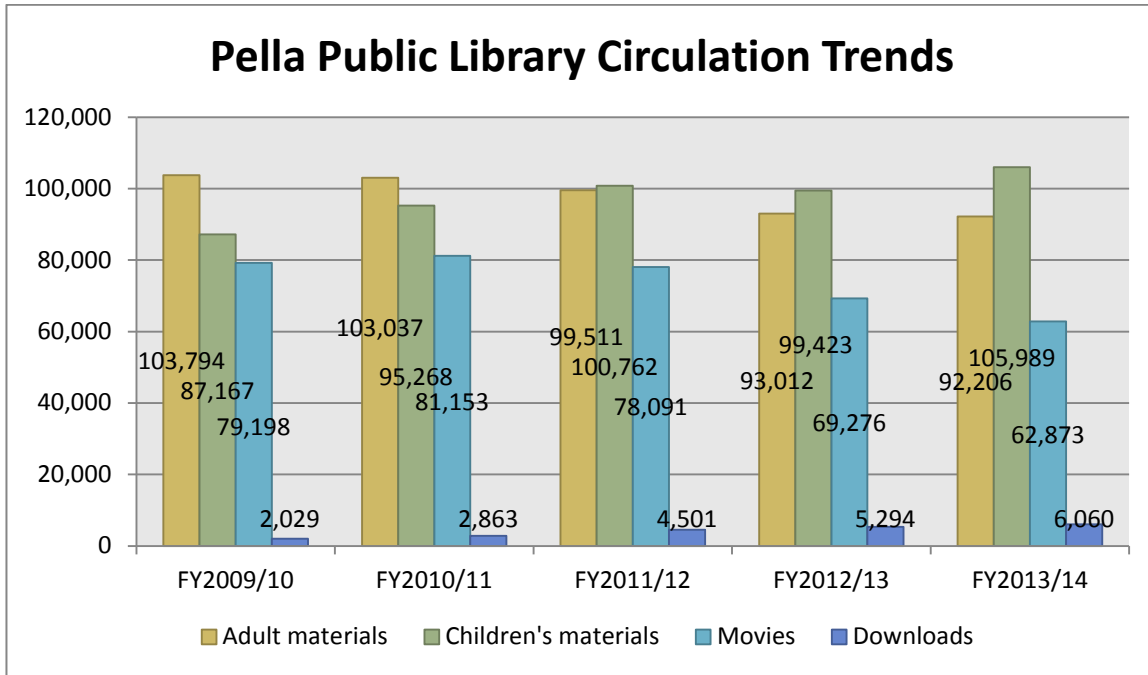
Sources of Funding
