8:00 to 8:45 a.m. Lap swim (5 lanes on M-T-W, 3 lanes on Tu-Th) reservations required

8:00 to 8:45 a.m. Aerobics (2 lanes on Tu-Th) reservations required

9:15 to 10:45 a.m. Rec swim team practice (5 lanes)

11:00 a.m. to 12:45 p.m. Lap swim (5 lanes) reservations required

1:00 to 6:00 p.m. Open swim first come/first served

6:15-7:45pm USA Swim Team

Saturdays:

1:00 to 6:00 p.m. Open swim first come/first served

Facility Features

The following features will be open and available for use: main outdoor pool, body slide, shallow end fish slide and play structure, deep end for open swim, restrooms/locker rooms

The following features will be closed: indoor pool, adventure river, drop slide, diving boards, water fountains

Reservations/Visiting the Pool

- Lap swim is by reservation only
- Open swim is first come/first served from 1:00 to 6:00 p.m.
- o 325 patrons are allowed in facility.
- Daily rates are \$7 per adult and \$6 per child or senior
- Summer memberships may be purchased at the regular price:
 - o Family \$199 for resident and \$239 for non-resident
 - o Individual \$88 for resident and \$106 for non-resident
 - o Youth/Senior \$75 for resident and \$95 for non-resident
- Patrons 12 years old and under must be accompanied by a parent or guardian over age 14
- Private party rentals and swim lessons will not be available during the summer season

- All those visiting the facility do so at their own risk

Facility Guidelines

- Time between activities is allowed for cleaning of high touch areas
- When not in the water, patrons must stay behind the yellow line
- Masks are recommended for patrons when they are not in the water
- Patrons may not sit on the edge of the pool or sunbathe in shallow areas
- Patrons in the water must be actively utilizing the area or they must exit to the patron area outside of the pool deck area
- Spacing marks will be applied to the concrete to separate patrons waiting in line to use the body slides or waiting to purchase concession items
- Concession items will be limited to beverages and prepackage items only
- Picnic tables and benches will be available; however, sanitization cannot be guaranteed
- Staff will not be allowed to report to work if they have a temperature of 100 degrees or higher or are showing other symptoms of COVID-19
- Additional signage will be posted throughout the facility to encourage social distancing and increased handwashing
